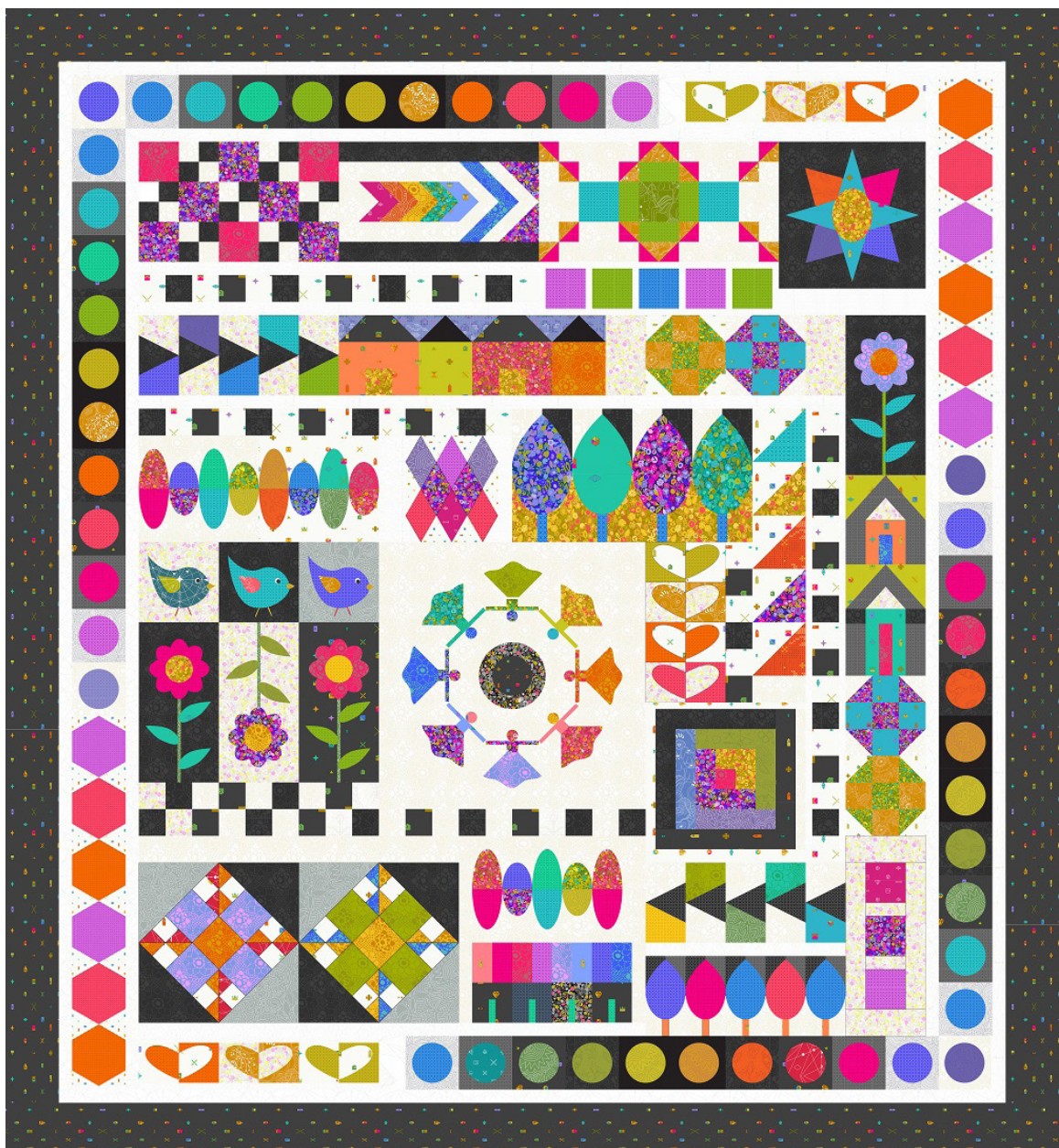
Welcome to the Dolly Mixtures Quiltalong!

FINISHING THE QUILT

For the standard size 79" x 86"

BATTING (WADDING):	87" x 94" (2 ½ yards (2.3m) off the roll)
BACKING (40-44" fabric)	6 yards (5.6m)
or BACKING (108" fabric)	2 ½ yards (2.3m)
BINDING	¾ yard (0.7m)

MAKING YOUR QUILT LARGER

If you wish to make your quilt larger than 79" x 86", you can choose any of the fabrics to add a border.


















A suggested 6" border would make the quilt 91" x 98" and requires 2 yards of fabric.

FINISHING THE QUILT

For the larger size 91" x 98"

BATTING (WADDING):	99" x 106" (3 yards (2.8m) off the roll)
BACKING (40-44" fabric)	8 ¼ yards (7.7m)
or BACKING (108" fabric)	3 yards (2.8m)
BINDING	⅞ yard (0.8m)

Polyfast™ is a 40wt trilobal polyester with a brilliant shimmer and excellent strength that is soft and smooth to the touch. Ideal for machine embroidery, including digitized embroidery on outerwear and home decor, it has been dyed and finished to withstand mild bleaching so you can embroider it on anything from towels to clothing to decorative pillow cases.

Recommended needle: 75/11 Embroidery.

This thread comes on 1000m reels and I will show you how to load these onto bobbins, or use a cup or beaker to hold the spool.

For piecing, I use a neutral cotton thread, such as Aurifil 50wt Col 2600

or

Wonderfil Konfetti KT906

Recommended needle: 80/12

Essential Tools and Supplies

Self healing Cutting Mat

(eg Creative Grids CGRMAT1218 or CGRMAT1824)

Ruler approximately 6" x 12" or 6" x 24" with 60 degree and 45 degree lines (eg Creative Grids CGR612)

Rotary Cutter with a new blade

Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot if you have one and a buttonhole stitch feature. You can use a zigzag if necessary but the buttonhole stitch has the best look.

General sewing supplies eg pins, seam ripper, small scissors for cutting thread, very sharp tip scissors for cutting applique.

Iron and Ironing board or wool pressing mat

Pencil, Fabric marker eg Frixion pen or Mechanical pencil.

Compass (if not using the CGRMT1 or Olfa Circle Cutter)

Teflon applique mat or baking paper to protect your iron

Fusible web, Tear away Stabiliser (light to medium weight)
